## Transformation Alliance

This month I have been working more actively in this NGO from Singapore. It was founded by an alliance of Singaporean churches (*Love Singapore*) with the purpose of “adopting” the many villages of *East Timor*. Each church is responsible for one of the 13 districts here and they're always sending groups of doctors, teachers and others to spend some days here. In some districts there are also groups that have long-term projects (1 year or more)

My job has been assisting these groups. We are organizing maps of each district, and also a directory with telephone numbers of important places (hotels, restaurants, travel agencies, government buildings) in each of the districts, with the purpose of connecting each one of the groups with its district more easily. I have also been going a few times to the airport to help groups that are coming in.

The trip was very calm and very pretty... and I could get to know one more district. God willing I will be able to visit all 13 of them =). It has been a really good learning experience. The political party *FRETILIN*, that lost the presidential and prime-minister election, has many followers in that region and the got rebellious against the government. They burned down many public buildings, houses and even some NGOs, that were associated with *Xanana Gusmão* (former president, now prime-minister). We could pray so that peace could be restored to that place.

**You can pray for that too!** However, we did not have any problems there... the Brazilian flag in the car's dashboard helps much more than we imagine... thank God for Brazil!

## Youth @ Prayer

We also promoted the youth prayer meeting. This month we had it at Bethany Church - the church I've been attending. We had a nice youth praise and worship time, in *English* and *Bahasa*, *Alisa* preached about relationship with God (she's from *Singapore* and also works with us for *TA*) e we also had a "*Cerdas Cermat*" - a Bible Challenge and they loved it! This will have them study the Bible more. The next day, at the youth service in my church they even asked me to do some more questions, just so they could be more prepared for the next one ;) . Since I'm talking about it... everyday I've strengthened my relationship with the youth there. My *Tetun* has developed a lot and I will start some *Bahasa* classes. **Please pray that my relationship there will be very fruitful and that God may be using my life to change their lives. =)**
